9. And with (the tribe of) Thamud, who clove the rocks in the valley.

10. And with Pharaoh, firm of might.

11. Who (all) were rebellious (to Allah) in these lands.

12. And multiplied iniquity therein.

13. Therefore thy Lord poured on them the disaster of His punishment.
